


Usage / Deployment Instructions

Note: Please type "**sharepoint**" as the host name while starting the instance. It is very important to do this as the machine won't work properly without this step. The reference screenshot is attached below:



Instance Name: ✓ The name can be 2 to 128 characters in length and can contain letters, Chinese characters, numbers, hyphens (-), underscores (_), and periods (.). It must start with a letter or Chinese character.

Description: The description can contain 2 to 256 characters. It cannot start with http:// or https://.

Host: ✓

For Linux-based systems and other systems: the name can be 2 to 64 characters in length. It can contain several segments delimited by periods (.). Each segment can contain uppercase letters, lowercase letters, numbers, or hyphens. Each segment cannot contain continuous periods or hyphens. The name cannot start or end with a period or hyphen. The new hostname will take effect after the instance restarts.

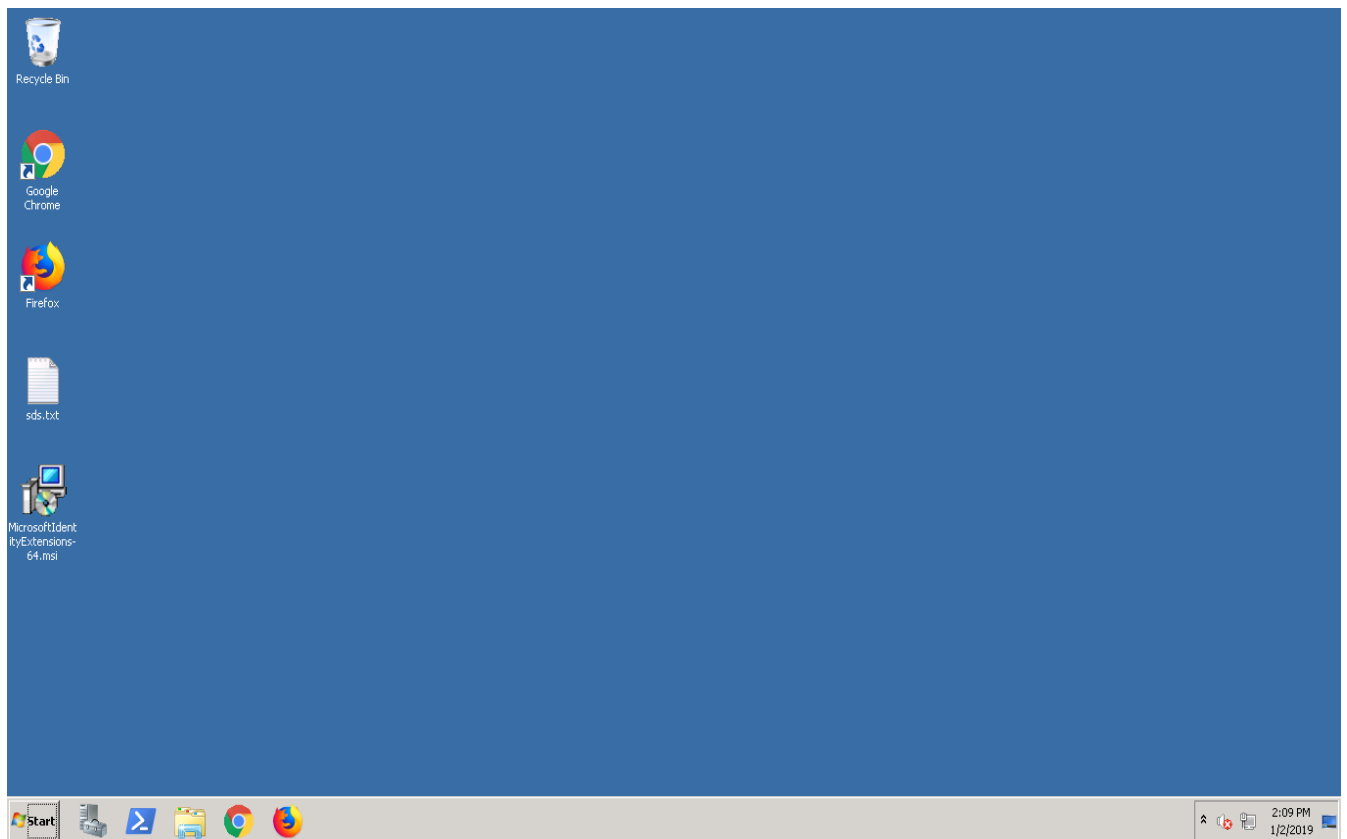

Step 1: Connect to the server using RDP as follows:

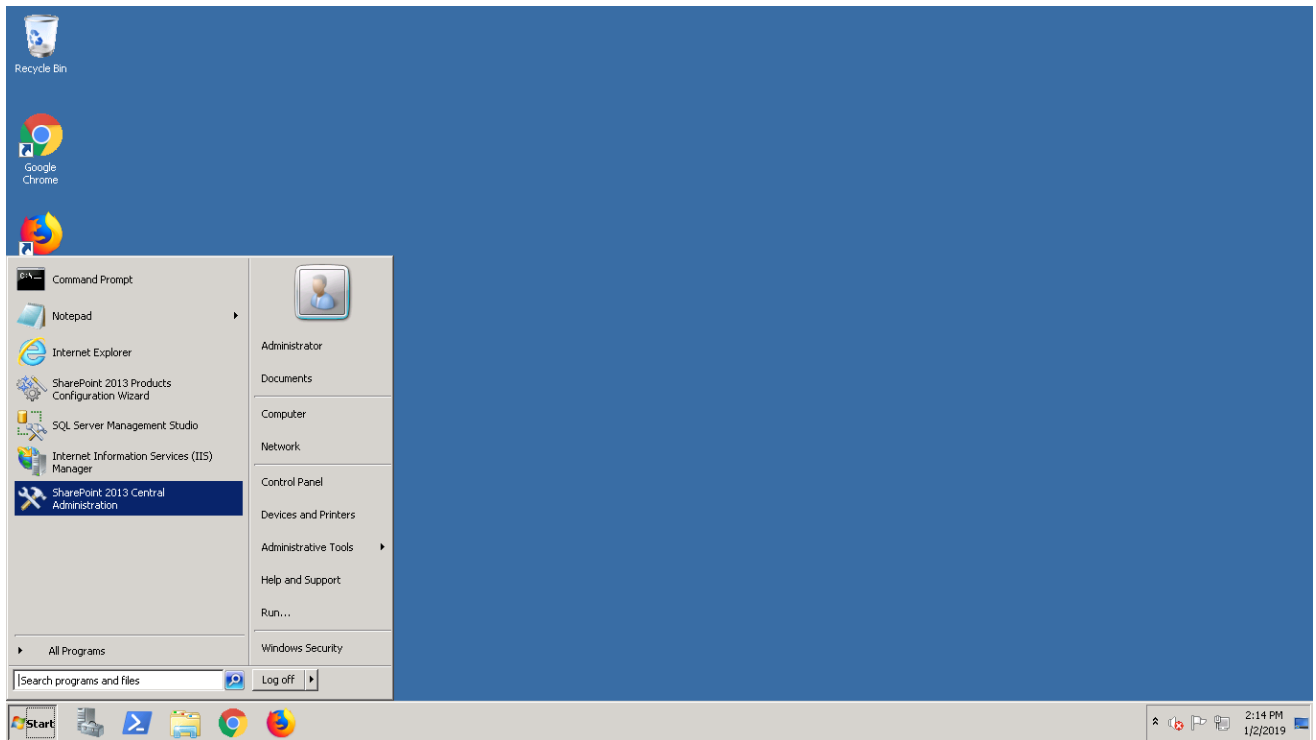
Open your Start Menu and type in there " Remote Desktop Connection". Then type your Public ip and connect with the following details shown below:

Password- miri@123



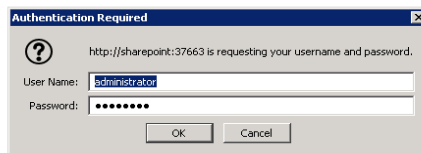
Step 2: Click on Start menu and select SharePoint 2013 Central Administration
