

## Usage / Deployment Instructions

**Step 1:** Use the browser to access the application at `http://<instance ip address>/zencart/zc_install` replace `<instance ip address>` with the actual IP address of the running instance.

**Note:** You will get the Instance IP Address as shown in the screenshot below:

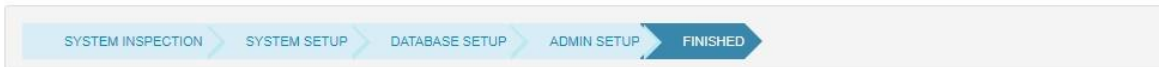



- Type(**do not copy**) the following command:


**Command:** `rm -rf /var/www/html/zencart/zc_install/`
