

## Usage / Deployment Instruction

Use the browser to access the application at <http://<instance ip address>> replace **<instance ip address>** with the actual ip address of the running instance.

### **Below are the installation steps:**

#### Step1: Start Installation

Welcome to WordPress. Before getting started, we need some information on the database. You will need to know the following items before proceeding.

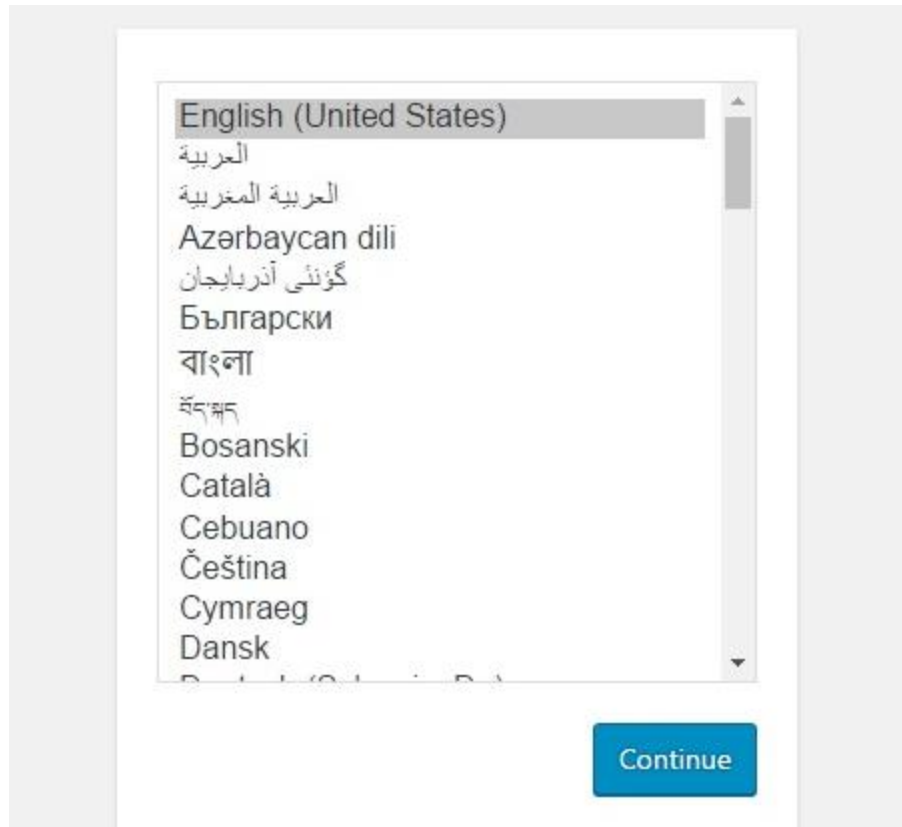
1. Database name
2. Database username
3. Database password
4. Database host
5. Table prefix (if you want to run more than one WordPress in a single database)

We're going to use this information to create a `wp-config.php` file. **If for any reason this automatic file creation doesn't work, don't worry. All this does is fill in the database information to a configuration file. You may also simply open `wp-config-sample.php` in a text editor, fill in your information, and save it as `wp-config.php`.** Need more help? [We got it.](#)

In all likelihood, these items were supplied to you by your Web Host. If you don't have this information, then you will need to contact them before you can continue. If you're all ready...

Below you should enter your database connection details. If you're not sure about these, contact your host.

<b>Database Name</b>	<input type="text" value="miriwordpress"/>	The name of the database you want to use with WordPress.
<b>Username</b>	<input type="text" value="miriwpuser"/>	Your database username.
<b>Password</b>	<input type="text" value="miri"/>	Your database password.
<b>Database Host</b>	<input type="text" value="localhost"/>	You should be able to get this info from your web host, if localhost doesn't work.
<b>Table Prefix</b>	<input type="text" value="wp_"/>	If you want to run multiple WordPress installations in a single database, change this.


